Weber is Professor Emeritus of Church Music at Lenoir-Rhyne University, Hickory, North Carolina, where he taught for twenty years and conducted the A Cappella and Chapel Choirs, and, along with his wife Florence Jowers, founded the sacred music program. Dr. Weber is a published, award-winning composer whose music is found in Evangelical Lutheran Worship and Lutheran Service Book. He was granted the doctor of musical arts degree in choral conducting from The University of Iowa, and has advanced degrees in organ and composition from Washington University, St. Louis, and from the Yale University School of Music and Institute of Sacred Music.
