Held the first Monday in March at the spacious San Ramon Marriott in Bishop Ranch, the EBWC is recognized by the community for programming excellence and has enjoyed sold out attendance of nearly 600 since its 2006 inaugural event.

The distinctive conference blends premier keynote and featured speaker presentations, breakout sessions focused on contemporary issues, exhibitor booths, a fully stocked bookstore, and author signings. Industry experts present interactive seminars on topics of critical importance and keen interest including personal growth, professional development, business leadership, health and nutrition, financial matters, volunteerism and philanthropy.

Conference highlights include continental breakfast, gourmet lunch, and an afternoon reception with wine, hors d'oeuvres, entertainment and prize drawings.
