**1. Friday Evening Kabbalat Shabbat Musical Service with a Shabbat meal.**

- a. The ensemble shares a beautiful Kabbalat Shabbat service lasting 45 minutes that enables hosts and guests to enter Shabbat in a joyful spirit. It is followed by a Shabbat meal, conversation, and possibilities for learning with Rabbi Dov Gartenberg. Hosts can choose to have the meal first followed by Kabbalat Shabbat.

**2. A Shabbat Tish: Friday Shabbat Meal or a Late Dessert Gathering Punctuated by Medleys of Jewish Music and Singing-**

- a. At a Tish the Heart of Shabbat Ensemble shares at least two 30 minute sets of Jewish/Hebrew songs that you and your guests will love. Familiar and new songs are shared with musical accompaniment and strong lead singing. Rabbi Gartenberg does musical midrash, telling stories of the history and the meaning of the lyrics to appreciate why these songs entered Jewish lore.

**3. Havdallah and End of Shabbat Tish**

- a. See above. The Tish takes place before or after Havdallah on Saturday evening depending on the time of the year. A Shabbat meal and dessert is the setting.

**4. Yom Tov (Jewish Festival) Tish**

- a. A festival home celebration and meal in which we share songs of the holiday and Jewish/Hebrew music and singing from all over the world.
