Lesson Plan for Sunday, January 29 and Wednesday, February 1

This lesson is an adaptation from the Child Lures School Program. The Archdiocese requires us to incorporate The Child Lures Program in our Religious Ed Program. This is a repeat lesson from a couple of years ago..... **The Emergency Lure.** We feel that this topic is important to be addressed at home with parents **AGAIN.**

Learning Objectives

*Emergencies need to be verified by checking with home.

*Families need to have a Family Plan of Action and need to emphasize importance to their children to stick to the plan.

Lesson Plan

1. Begin by designating a time and space in your home when your family will gather.
2. Use the following questions or similar questions to get conversation started.
3. What are some examples of family emergencies?
4. Could these emergencies really happen?
5. How would you feel if someone told you that one of these emergencies happened at home or to a family member?
6. Do you think you would be thinking clearly and reacting in a safe way?
7. Let's put together our OWN Family Plan in case of an emergency so that you know what to do if someone comes up to you and tells you that you need to go with them because of something happening at home or to your family.
Devise Family Plan.....(i.e. Secret Code)
8. Make sure everyone understands it and agrees to stick to the plan.
