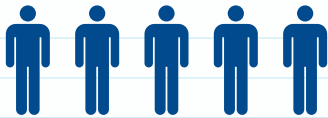

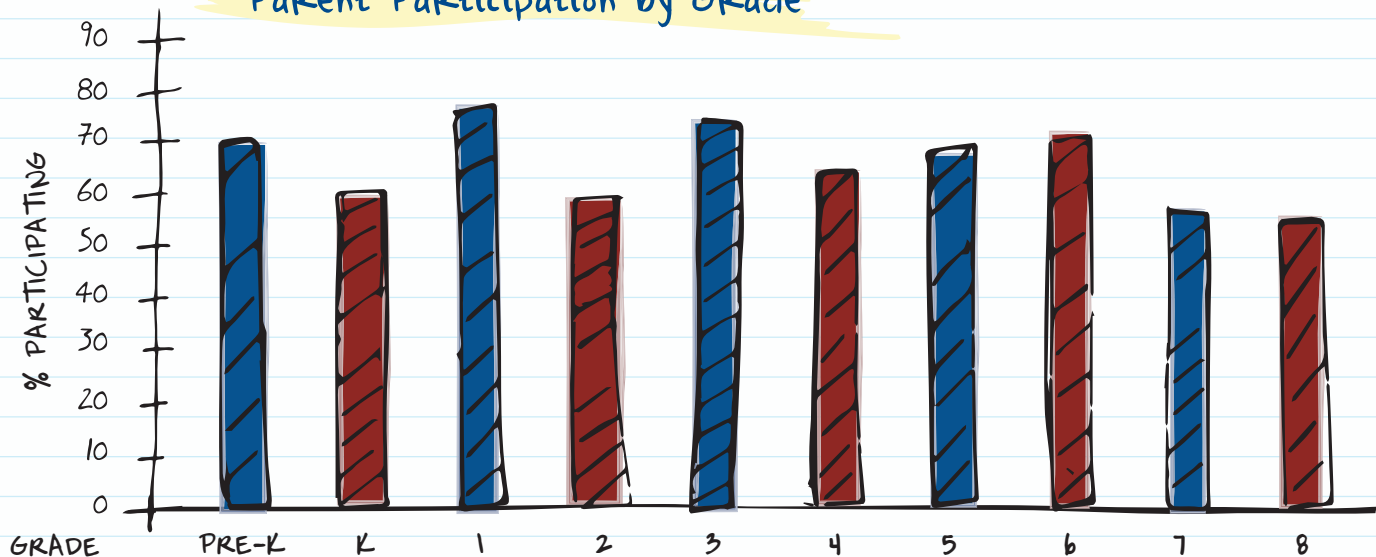

Parent Participation by Grade

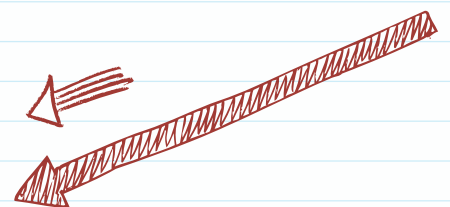

ONLINE AUCTION

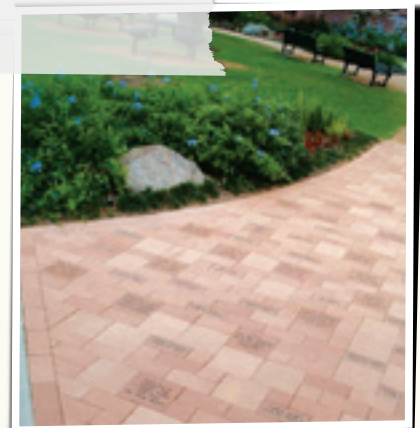

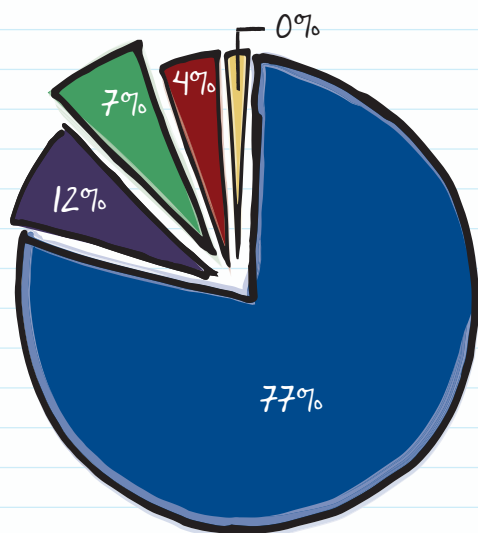

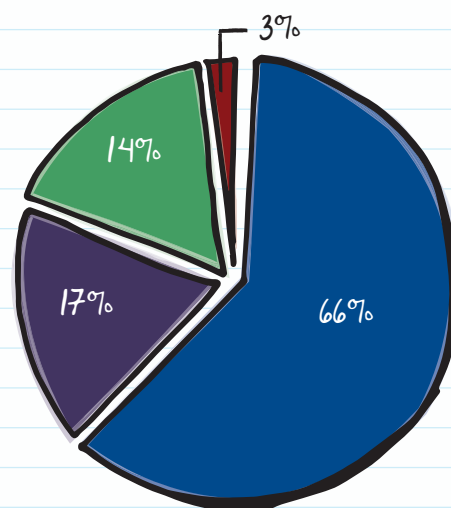
