Budget Item	Total	Justification
Lodging	\$ 1,704	Objective for the 2017 National competition is to book rooms at the competition site. The total is obtained from multiplying \$426 x 4 nights
Transportation	\$ 7,115	The team will be flying to Orlando, FL.
Student Registration	\$ 1,720	Registration fee for students will be \$215. Goal is to take 8 students to conference. Price is subject to change.
Food	\$ 900	Portion shows student travel expenses for 8 students for both national/regional competitions.
Materials & Supply	\$ 1,250	This portion of funding shows the direct research towards building a model MSE wall.
Team Shirts	\$ 275	The team will be acquiring polo's as team shirts. Will cover 15 possible members plus advisor.
Poster	\$ 150	Portion shows the technical poster that is needed for the regional geotechnical competition.
Total	\$ 13,114
