**Leadership Maury** is a personal development program designed to motivate participants to develop and enhance the quality of their leadership in addressing pertinent community needs.

## CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

### *Class Members Must:*

Reside in Maury County or within the town limits of Spring Hill; and work in Maury County; or make a significant contribution to Maury County through volunteer work.

### *Persons will be favored for selection who:*

- Have demonstrated a desire to serve the community through past civic involvement.
- Are willing to seek leadership roles on public/private boards, in volunteer organizations, or in public office.
- Are motivated to improve their skills.
- Have potential for advancement to leadership roles in their own organizations, or are already in such positions.
- Have an occupation such that they are not likely to be relocating from the county in the immediate future.
- Will commit to participate fully through attendance; and as members, continue for at least one year to be involved in the program as a resource person, a program planner, a board member, or other roles as needed.

#### CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Class members must:
1. Reside in Maury County or within the town limits of Spring Hill
- And
2. Work in Maury County OR make a significant contribution to Maury County through volunteer work.  
(Exceptions of place of residence may be considered)

Applicants will be selected each year who are most apt to utilize their leadership ability for the long-term benefit of the community and whose inclusion in that year's class furthers the objective of the program to bring together persons with disparate backgrounds and interest.

Persons will be favored for selection who:

1. Have demonstrated a desire to serve the community by past civic activities
2. Are willing to seek leadership roles on public and private boards, in volunteer organizations, or in public office.
3. Are motivated to improve their skills
4. Have potential for advancement to leadership positions in their own organizations, or are already in such position.
5. Have an occupation such that they are not likely to be relocating from the county in the immediate future.
6. Will commit to participate fully in the Leadership Maury program, meet its attendance requirements, and as alumni continue for at least one year their involvements with the program as resource persons, program planners, Board members or other roles as needed.

#### ATTENDANCE POLICY

**Leadership Maury is designed as a total experience in which a class member attends an opening retreat and then a full-day session once a month. A different topic is addressed at each session. To receive the benefits the program intends, a class member should attend all sessions. Therefore, the Leadership Maury policy on attendance is as follows:**

1. A class member must attend all of the opening retreat to continue in the class.
2. A class member should attend all monthly sessions. A class member missing more than one session, without an acceptable excuse will be dropped from the class, without tuition refund, and may reapply for the next year's class.
3. A class member missing more than one session must submit make-up work as directed by and to the satisfaction of the coordinator of Leadership Maury.
4. A class member missing two halves of a session (half = any part of a day missed) will be considered to have missed one session.
