PATRICK DELICES

Patrick Delices is a Pan-African scholar and public intellectual who taught the History of Haiti, Caribbean Politics, Black Politics, and African-Caribbean International Relations at Hunter College, Department of Africana and Puerto Rican/Latino Studies. He served as a research fellow at Columbia University for the late, Pulitzer Prize historian Manning Marable and as a research assistant for Dr. Leonard Jeffries Jr., the former chairperson of the Department of Black Studies at the City College of New York.

Patrick Delices earned a BA in International Relations and Black Studies along with an MS in Educational Administration and Supervision from the City College of New York. He also earned an Ed. M in Higher Education Administration from Teachers College, Columbia University; an MBA in Ouantitative Finance, Business Law, and Global Business from New York University, Stern School of Business; and an MPA in International Economics Policy and Management from Columbia University, School of International and Public Affairs. Moreover, Patrick Delices holds a certificate in Performance Measurement and Management from Harvard University, Kennedy School of Government; a certificate in Decolonial Studies from the Universitat Autonoma de Barcelona in Spain; and a certificate in Critical Islamic Theology and Muslim Liberation Studies from the Universidad de Granada in Spain.

During the winter of 2014, as part of the first African-American delegation to Western Sahara and as a valuable member of the Institute of the Black World. Patrick Delices visited Algeria and various Western Sahara refugee camps on a fact finding mission. Furthermore, Patrick engaged in a research project and conference in Haiti during the fall of 2014 with Professor James Small and Mambo Asogwe Bayvinah Bello, in honor of Emperor Jean Jacques Dessalines and the Haitian Revolution. He has also visited and conducted research in the Dominican Republic, Cuba, Brazil, Chile, China, South Korea, Spain, Kenya, Tanzania, Zanzibar, and Egypt.

Currently, **Patrick Delices** is a contributing writer/journalist and political analyst for the Black Star News and the New York Amsterdam News and is working on two research projects: a book about his father, Georges Chardin Delices, Haitian soccer legend, and another book regarding the global impact of the Haitian Revolution. Patrick also published "The Digital Economy" in the Journal of International Affairs; "Cementing Scholarship with Service: Dr. Ben at the Foothills of the Mountains of the Moon Where the God Hapi Dwells" in the Journal of Pan- African Studies; "The African Origin of Haitian Vodou: From the Nile Valley to the Haitian Valleys" in the text Vodou in the Haitian Experience; and "Oath to the Ancestors: The Haitian Flag is Rooted in Vodou" in the text Vodou in Haitian Memory.
