Understanding the PXT Select™ assessment

DIRECTIONS: ABC NH/VT EDUCATION CENTER (DO NOT RELY ON GPS NAVIGATION)

From I-93S in Concord: Take Exit 15 E to I-393 East. Take Exit 3 to Route 106 and head Right onto 106-South.

Proceed 1 mile, past the Steeplegate Mall. The ABC Chapter Office & Education Center is on the Right at the corner of Route 106 and Chenell Drive.

From I-93N in Concord: Take Exit 13. Proceed right onto Route 3-NoRouteh; Manchester Street. Move into the left lane and take the first left onto Old Turnpike Road; cross over Airport Road and continue on Regional Drive to Route 106. At the lights turn Right onto Route 106. We are at the next intersection. The ABC Chapter Office & Education Center is on the Right at the corner of Route 106 and Chenell Drive.

From the Seacoast: Take Route 4-West to I-393 West. Take the Route 106-South exit on your Left. Proceed 1 mile, past the Steeplegate Mall. The ABC Chapter Office & Education Center is on the Right at the corner of Route 106 and Chenell Drive.

PARKING: Parking and Entrance for our **Education Center** is at the **rear of the building**.
