Approved documentation options:

- A diploma from an acceptable secondary or post-secondary institution in the field(s) to be taught  
**OR**
- A resume documenting experience in the curriculum title(s) or specific modules(s) the individual intends to teach  
**OR**
- Documented evidence of successful completion of the National Craft Assessment and Certification Program (NCACP) assess in appropriate field(s)  
**OR**
- A license granted by a state in the field(s) to be taught  
**OR**
- Relevant certification by a State Department of Education.
