CONSTRUCTION UNEMPLOYMENT AT LOWEST RATE IN 16 YEARS



September construction unemployment rates improved in 32 states and the nation on a year-over-year basis. The national construction unemployment rate of 5.2 percent was 0.3 percent

lower than a year ago, according to data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS). **NH had the 9th lowest construction industry unemployment rate of 4% (the same as September 2015). Vermont was ranked 13 with a construction industry unemployment rate of 4.3% (a .01% increase over September 2015).** It should be noted that due to its proximity and impact on the NH construction industry, Massachusetts had the 5th lowest construction industry unemployment rate of 3.3% (a 1.3% decrease since September 2015).

Nationally, this was the lowest September construction unemployment rate since 2000, when it was 4.6 percent. BLS data also reported that the industry employed 208,000 more people than in September 2015.

September 2016 marks the sixth year of uninterrupted monthly year-over-year rate decreases in the national construction unemployment rate that began in October 2010. The industry-specific unemployment rates are not seasonally adjusted, so it is important to note states' performance on a year-ago basis.

The Top Five States

The top five states with the lowest estimated construction unemployment rates in order from lowest rate to highest they were:

1. Colorado
2. South Dakota
3. Idaho and North Dakota (tie)
5. Massachusetts

The Bottom Five States

The five states with the highest construction unemployment rates in order from lowest to highest rates were:

46. Alabama
47. Pennsylvania
48. Rhode Island
49. New Mexico
50. Alaska

IMPROVED WORKFORCE PRODUCTIVITY IS ESSENTIAL DURING A LABOR SHORTAGE

ABC Offers Programs to Support Your Effort



Although the emphasis on recruiting new workers is critical, contractors are missing something if they do not have an equal focus on upgrading the skills of their existing workforce. Improved workforce productivity is essential during a labor shortage because it allows projects to be completed with fewer hours and with a reduced need for additional craft professionals. Skill upgrade programs can increase the productivity of the existing workforce by as much as 10 percent, maybe even more. These are individuals who have already chosen the construction industry, and we do not need to recruit them. A study by the Construction Industry Institute (CII) shows that when contractors invest 1 percent of their total project labor budget on training, there is an estimated 11 percent improvement rate in productivity for capital projects. Contractors who train their workforce have a more productive workforce and are better prepared when labor shortages occur. Workers who are formally trained are typically more motivated in their careers, make better decisions and perform with a higher level of skill. By developing younger talent from within, employees can take on new roles in the company as mentors, instructors, supervisors or project managers, among others.
