Appling Leads is a nine month adult leadership program developed through a partnership between the Baxley-Appling County Chamber of Commerce and the J.W. Fanning Institute for Leadership Development at the University of Georgia. Appling Leads exists to engage a diverse team of community members, empowered to commit to Appling County, and educated in leadership practices. The program targets individuals who represent all segments of the community, have demonstrated commitment to Appling County and have a sincere interest in serving the community as a leader.

Tuition is \$350 per participant. Tuition covers all sessions, meals and overnight accommodations. A \$150 deposit is due with application and the balance of \$200 must be paid by orientation day, September 7th 2017.
