Pre-k – Kindergarten and Grades 3 – 8

Hand in Hand includes a daily combination of therapeutic social skills provided by clinicians, along with an inclusion program to reinforce what was learned and to encourage social engagement with others. Each potential participant should call for an interview with the Inclusion Coordinator. Families will be notified of acceptance into the program based on this process.

Two 3-week sessions:

June 26 – July 14 and July 17 – August 4

Pre-k: Mon. – Fri., 8:45 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Kindergarten: Mon. – Fri., 8:45 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Grades 3 – 8: Mon. – Fri., 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.
