ACTIVITY NUMBER: 10702

DESCRIPTION: Youth swim lessons program of eight sessions. Class schedule may be changed or cancelled according to enrollment and demand. See Guidelines and Goals.

LOCATION: Greenwich Boys and Girls Club, 4 Horseneck Lane, Greenwich

REGISTRATION: Online registration begins March 4 and is only available to Greenwich residents. To register online go to: www.greenwichct.org/webtrac and select “Activity Registration”.

Mail-in registration and in-person registration at the Parks & Recreation Office begins March 13.

If not yet provided in 2017, residents must provide proof of residency and non-residents must provide identification and proof of address. Resident primary addressee must provide two proofs and any household member 25 years or older must provide one proof for the purchase of passes, activities or tickets. Proofs for Greenwich residents may include: *residential lease, utility bill (gas, electric, water, oil), credit card bill, bank statement (not mortgage) cable bill, phone bill (not cell), driver’s license, DMV ID.* Proofs of Greenwich residential address must be current and show resident name.

We accept Visa, MasterCard and Discover credit cards for resident online registration and at the Town Hall Parks and Recreation Office. There are no refunds and we do not pro-rate fees. Requests for credit will only be considered if received in writing prior to the start of the program. There is a \$15.00 administrative fee for credits and a \$25.00 fee for any returned checks.

GOALS FOR CLASS LEVELS

PARENT/CHILD	Basic water safety, blowing bubbles, going under, kicking, reaching with arms, using a kickboard. No instructors for this class.
NOVICE	Basic water safety, blowing bubbles, going under, front crawl stroke using kickboard, back float, jumping.
BEGINNER I	Front crawl stroke 25 feet without kickboard, back float, jumping, introduction to back stroke and introduction to diving.
OLDER BEGINNER	Front crawl stroke 25 feet without kickboard, back float, jumping, introduction to backstroke, and introduction to diving.
BEGINNER II	Front crawl stroke 50 feet, back float, back stroke 25-50 feet, introduction to breaststroke, elementary backstroke, treading water.
ADULT BEGINNER	Front crawl stroke, back float, backstroke, breaststroke, elementary backstroke, treading water.
ADVANCED BEGINNER	Front crawl stroke and backstroke 50 feet refined, breaststroke 50 feet, introduction to elementary backstroke, diving, treading water.
INTERMEDIATE	Front crawl stroke, backstroke and breaststroke 50 feet refined, elementary backstroke 50 feet, diving, treading water.

GUIDELINES FOR SWIMMING LESSONS

Shallow End of the Pool

PARENT/CHILD	Child should be walking and out of diapers. One adult (parent or guardian) per child must be in the water. Approximately ages 24 months – 4 years. No instructors in water for this class.
NOVICE	Child should not be afraid of the water. Child must be 3 ½ feet tall from the bottom of his/her to chin to his/her feet. Approximately ages 4 – 5 years.
BEGINNER I	Child must have passed NOVICE and/or should be able to swim front crawl stroke for 25 feet with a kickboard. Approximately ages 6 – 7 years.
BEGINNER II	Child MUST have passed BEGINNER I and/or should be able to swim front crawl stroke for 25 feet without floatation device. Child should have had some prior experience with backstroke. Approximately ages 8 – 9 years.

Deep End of the Pool

ADVANCED BEGINNER	Child MUST have passed BEGINNER II and/or should be able to swim front crawl for 50 feet. Child should also have some prior experience with backstroke and breaststroke.
INTERMEDIATE	Child MUST have passed ADVANCED BEGINNER and/or should be able to swim front crawl and backstroke for 50 feet. Child should also have had some prior experience with Breaststroke and elementary backstroke.
