**Members of MPA who are also APA Members, Fellows, or Voting Associate Members are eligible to nominate and to be nominated for the APA Council Representative Seat.** Please take the time to consider the members of the Association who would best represent your views and nominate them. We are particularly interested in receiving nominations that represent the diversity of MPA's membership. If you know someone whose professional or academic approach you would like to see represented as APA Council Representative, nominate them. If you have served on a MPA committee and liked the approach, energy or commitment of your colleague, please nominate them. If you are that person and are interested in serving, consider self-nominating.

**Terms of Office**

The APA Council Representative for Massachusetts will have a 3 year term, beginning January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2022.

**Responsibilities and Qualifications**

Council is the legislative body of APA, and has fiduciary responsibility for APA's affairs and funds. Therefore, Council Representatives are required to focus on APA's viability and ability to serve the members and the public

Nominees should have significant governance experience (for instance having sat on the MPA Board of Directors) and be ready to commit significant time and energy to the role. There are two main meetings per year, lasting for 3 days each, one in February in Washington and one at the time and place of the Annual Convention.

Representatives are expected to read materials in preparation for meetings and to be fully engaged in Council Meetings. They also respond to emails throughout the year, and participate in Caucus meetings depending on their interest and affinity. Finally, our Council Representative sits on the MPA Board of Directors with all attendant duties and responsibilities.

Candidates may be nominated by MPA members or they may self-nominate. Nominations must be received at the MPA Office by Friday, January 12, 2018. Please use the form provided.
