This family-friendly mission trip will include service projects for all ages and skill levels. Projects may include construction, landscaping, painting, crafting, and visiting the sick or elderly.

When? Thursday, June 14 – Sunday, June 17. Arrive at camp at your leisure on Thursday evening and leave after camp clean-up on Sunday morning.

Where? Frenchburg, KY, approximately 2.5 hours from Cincinnati

Lodging? We will be staying at Bethel Baptist Camp which features four bunkhouses, restrooms and shower house, a dining hall/gathering space, kitchen and grill areas, and plenty of room for kids to play in the creek, in the field, or even on the putt-putt course! You are welcome to stay in a bunkhouse, pitch your own tent on the camp's grounds, or book a room in a nearby hotel. (Hotel rooms are not included in the cost of the trip. Hotel reservations and payment are the responsibility of the participant.)

Transportation? Participants are responsible for their own transportation.

Cost? \$20 per person. Cost includes meals, lodging at the camp, and supplies.
