A Memory Gem

Loren W. Campbell, the late former Kiwanis Club of AA past president, began his judicial career following his service as an United Methodist clergyman in Dixboro, MI. Then, after graduating from the **U-M Law School**, he evolved to a local attorney and a probate judge. Campbell (at right, with hand raised) is sworn into the bar by the Washtenaw County Clerk in 1949.

A club niche: he is thought to be the only past club president to formally baptize a former club president, **Dale Leslie**. The ceremony occurred when Dale was an infant in Dixboro and Loren was Rev. Campbell, pastor, of the Dixboro Methodist Church. Loren joined the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor in 1952 and remained a member in the organization until his passing in 1996.
