TODAY'S PROGRAM...

Steve Hiller introduced today's speaker, **Brenda Quiet**, the Victim Advocate Coordinator for the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office. When the October 1st mass shooting occurred at the Las Vegas Harvest Music Festival, the Nevada Attorney General requested assistance from victim advocates around the country. Michigan sent six advocates including Brenda.

She gave a very emotional talk about her four days working with the victims of the shooting that killed 58 and injured 546. A family assistance center was established. Brenda's group listened to the victim's stories, completed needs assessments, and directed them to the available services including meals, lodging and transportation.

Over 1,500 victims were assisted while Brenda was in Las Vegas. Brenda is quoted as saying "I was overwhelmed by the outpouring of assistance and aid by the Las Vegas community and the entire country. It was inspiring to witness the community and the country rally and support those that needed help and healing. People from across the country came together to help others, making donations and working long hours without being asked. It helped to restore the belief that people are kind and good."

1782: Deborah Sampson disguises herself as a man to fight for her country in the Revolutionary War.

1851: Sojourner Truth's spontaneous "Ain't I a Woman?" speech electrifies the woman's rights convention in Akron, Ohio.

1916: Jeannette Rankin becomes the first woman elected to Congress.

1928: Amelia Earhart becomes the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.

1939: Eleanor Roosevelt, then first lady, resigns from the Daughters of the American Revolution after they bar Marian Anderson from singing at Constitution Hall due to her race.

1955: Rosa Parks is arrested in Montgomery, Alabama, sparking the American civil rights movement.

1977: Janet Guthrie becomes the first woman to drive in the Indy 500.

1987: Aretha Franklin becomes the first woman inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame

1997: Madeleine Albright is sworn in as the first female Secretary of State.

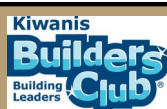

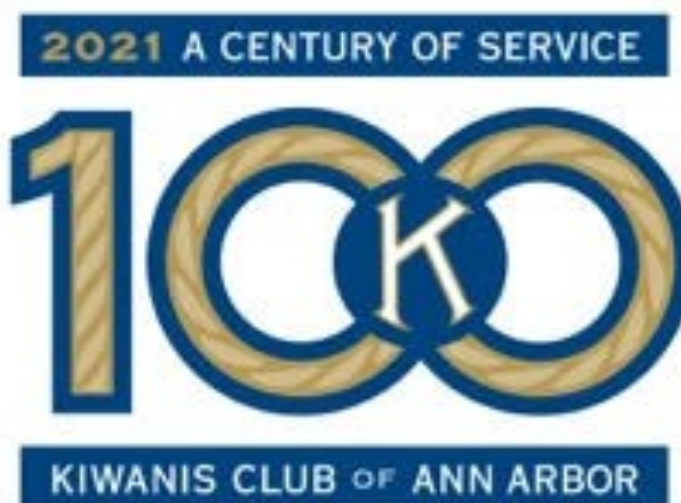
