February 3 Stamping Fun!

Children will create their own stamps and have fun using them to create paper treasures.

March 3 Nutty About Nature!

Children will use fun items from nature (leaves, pinecones, etc.) to make self-portraits/ sculptures.

Children will have fun cup stacking, juggling, jumping rope, tossing frisbees and more.
