Mathletics: Find Summer Assignments to Redo after ALL 10 Have Been Attempted

1. Login to student account at www.mathletics.com.
2. Use the Search Tool located below **Activities**. 
3. Students must clear the “Vault” by attempting all 10 assignments before the **Activities** title will appear.
4. Type in the name of the Activity your student wishes to redo from the list of grade level assigned activities.
5. The result of your search should appear below **Activities**.
6. Click the title of the Activity to begin.
7. Redo all 10 questions in the Activity.
8. **Or**, click one of the circles below **My Awards** in the lower left hand corner of the **Activities** page (see image to the right). Click “**How do these work?**” to guide you on finding the scores earned.
9. Again, match the title to the list of grade level assigned activities.
10. Click the title of the Activity to begin.
11. Redo all 10 questions in the Activity.
12. Your student has unlimited attempts for all 10 summer assignments.
13. The math teacher will only use the score from the last attempt for the final average.



Example:

I am a rising 6th grade student with assignments from Mr. Inman. One of the assignments I wish to retry is titled, Equivalent Fractions 1. I type “Equivalent Fractions” in the search bar after logging into my Mathletics account. I get two results, see image below. I choose the bar that matches the exact title I wish to redo.
