Take a look at something more common some of you made heard about are miracles. Acts of divine intervention from God himself. Those who have been blessed to witness miracles have seen the evidence of God with their own eyes, while the story they spread helps strengthen the faith with these odd occurrences. Let's take my favorite miracle for example the miracle of Lanciano which occurred with the eucharist , eucharist being basically communion for the Catholics. In this miracle the priest was beginning to lose his faith so while he was consecrating the wafer it began to bleed eventually the blood and the wafer where put on display in the sanctuary. Now, this is where things get interesting the blood dried into five pellets and in the 1500s when weighed each of the weighed the same in any amount. The big bang theory originated from Monseigneur Georges Lemaître, a Belgian Catholic Priest. How could something so huge happen in an instant without any outside force? Of course it can't be just a coincidence that the universe was formed in such a way. Another part to this is that after the the big bang the universe will expand to a point where it will collapse on itself and create a new universe but then the question comes again, who started this all? God of course. Now look at all the planets we have discovered both near and far and there is something odd, only Earth can bear life naturally. Not only does earth of life, but we humans are disproportionately advanced compared to other life on the planet in terms of complexity of our central nervous system. Today's scripture comes from acts and Psalms and shows past evidence of the existence of God through the deeds of others such as Paul and the Lycaonian man. When the man was healed through Paul he stated that the gods had come down in human form when simply it was an action through Paul, just how God works through all of us and this served as proof of God's existence through the kind actions of Paul, and then to continue on and act humbly, as one would before the Lord. This teaches us that we as individuals can serve as living proof of God through our kind actions towards our fellow man. Try to be the best you that you can be in God's name through the actions you produce in your community, not to be recognized as a good person, or even to just get it to heaven so to speak but do it so that you can be living evidence of you God.
