### Awards Nomination Form

NAMI Oklahoma designates a standing list of potential awards that may or may not be made at each Annual Meeting in the form of a plaque or certificate. Nominations must be received in the state office using the nomination form provided by the stated deadline on the nomination form.

I / we wish for the nominee to be considered for:

- NAMI Oklahoma Volunteer Service Award**—To recognize achievement or long and distinguished service in the meeting of NAMI Oklahoma's goals of service, education, advocacy & research.
- Advocacy Award** – To recognize achievement or long and distinguished service in the five core competencies of grassroots: ethics and values; integrity and trust; listening; managing vision and purpose; and motivating others.
- Achievement Award**—To recognize a person with a mental health condition for his or her service, courage and leadership on behalf of people with mental illness.
- Affiliate of the Year Award**—To recognize a local NAMI affiliate 's outstanding achievement in the area of service, advocacy, education, or other venues. This award will reflect one or more of the following areas: membership, Walk contributions, program activity, community outreach, and organizational development. Program activity references all of the NAMI signature education and peer support programs, as well as other local program activity focused on peer support, education and advocacy, including but not limited to Mental Illness Awareness Week / Month, legislative advocacy, and collaboration with community agencies and organizations, including law enforcement agencies.
- Professional Service Award**—To recognize the outstanding contributions made by a professional that has provided extraordinary support for NAMI Oklahoma initiatives on behalf of persons with mental health conditions and their family members.
- Professional Organization Award**—To recognize a professional organization which has done the most to provide support or service to persons with mental illness.
- Legislator Award**—To recognize Oklahoma legislators who have made a significant contribution to the goals of NAMI Oklahoma.
- Media Award**—To recognize Oklahoma media who have made a significant contribution to the goals of NAMI Oklahoma.
