Suggestions:

- Some tables took longer than ten minutes, some tables hit the 10 minutes right on the mark. For next year, I would suggest 15 intervals and room with a reasonable AC temperature. After 20 minutes I felt as if I was in Antarctica rather than South LA.*
- Allow more time for the orientation. Maybe half a day. It was rushed at the end, and I feel like I wasn't able to grasp all of the information because the league staff that was presenting information had to rush through. And they may have forgotten something that could have been important information to an attendee!*
- I think this should be presented at the Chapter level annually and be part of the general session (not a break-out session) at the convention.*
- This is important info that needs to reach many!*

- *I think a power point presentation and a League staffer to present the power point would be great at a chapter level.*
- *I think a power point along with League staff to present during the general session of the annual conference would reach a great cross-section on members.*
- *A few more minutes per subject! Perhaps more space between tables so you don't hear discussion from each group.*
- *A little more time at each station and maybe have a laptop at each station to show how to access the info on the internet.*
- *Don't have it at every LA GAC. I'd like to see it move around with different events so more people can get exposure to the services.*
- *Loved the energy and teamwork.*
- *Please consider offering again with a little longer time for each table, I felt rushed at the end. No matter though I now know who to contact at the League for what I may need in my work at the local level. Thanks!*
- *Just a little more time at the tables. There were a few where we got cut off when the LCUL staff still had more information to share, or we didn't have an adequate amount of time for questions. I loved the idea regardless!*
