Clothing

TUXES AND DRESSES (tux shirts, bowtie, cummerbund, studs, black socks, black nylons, black dress shoes – HANG UP UNIFORMS IMMEDIATELY UPON CHECK-IN, TOO!)

Final Reminders

- All students must be at SeaTac Airport at 7:00 p.m. this Friday, April 7, to check-in with Alaska Airlines. Check-in with your chaperone upon arrival.
- All students must have a photo ID. For students 18 or older, this must be a valid legal photo ID, such as Driver's License or Passport. For students 17 or less, a school ASB card will also suffice.
- Please utilize one carry-on bag and one personal item (purse/backpack) to avoid extra baggage fees. Large instruments that do not meet TSA carry-on guidelines may be checked at the ticket counter as part of our group. Small instruments should be packed in suitcases, in backpacks or carried on as your personal item. As an option, instruments may be checked at the gate, but may still be subject to the checked baggage fees. (See Alaska's website for specific details)
