## Host Agreement

1. In our quest to be neighborly, authentic servants we are open to small groups i.e. less than 15, as we will incur expenses that include, but are not limited to prep and clean up, utilities, fuel, bait, etc...Thus, a modest donation is encouraged.

**\*Seasonal Exploration Package:** Visit Zachariah's Acres and explore all season. Your students will explore the miracles of nature on four times during the school year.

Suggested Donation: \$500 for a class room of 15 students or less.

**\*School Field Trip:** Visit Zachariah's Acres and participate in a wide range of nature-based, therapeutic activities including fishing, nature walk, garden exploration, and more.

Suggested Donation: \$10 per student. **Minimum donation of \$75 per group**
