- Learn how **OVEC Head Start staff and the directors and staff at Kreative KidZ and Amazing Children** upgraded facilities, trained staff in partnership with the University of Louisville, created a laser focus on school readiness, improved Infant Toddler Environmental Rating Scale (ITERS) scores and KY All STARS ratings, and empowered parents with a new, strategic approach to home visits.

ENVISION THE FUTURE

What would happen if ...? What would this look like at home? Can you imagine if we...?

- The National Governor's Association funded the Governor's Office for Early Childhood's School Readiness Summits. Since 2015, 46 school district teams participated. Team members included: district representatives, child care representatives, Head Start representatives, Community Early Childhood Council representatives and community partners. The teams learned to strategically use data to discern the most at risk children in their communities, and then collaborated on 30-60-90 Day Action Plans to increase school readiness.
- Governor's Office of Early Childhood Staff will be on hand to help you **use data and share information about programs available to Kentucky children.**
- Teams will **brainstorm and begin a planning process** for implementation at home.
