



Alberta HUB, in collaboration with provincial staff and partner organizations in the Alberta HUB Region, has initiated an exploration of very high-speed (gigabit) Broadband opportunities, needs, benefits and strategic approaches relevant to the Alberta HUB Region and local municipalities within it.

Accessible, affordable and reliable high-speed Broadband services, provided in a coordinated and interconnected system, is fundamental to supporting economic competitiveness locally and regionally, enabling greater social connectedness and well-being of the Region's population, supporting education, health and community service delivery and promoting environmental sustainability across the Region.

High-speed Broadband services provide foundational infrastructure for community prosperity, resiliency and quality of life – not unlike roads, electricity, water and wastewater and other essential utilities that support economic activity and community life.
