June 25- June 29

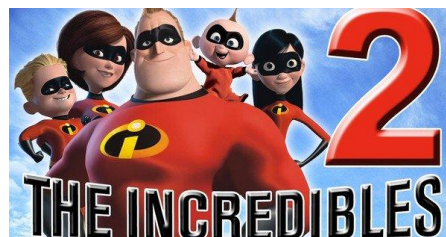
