

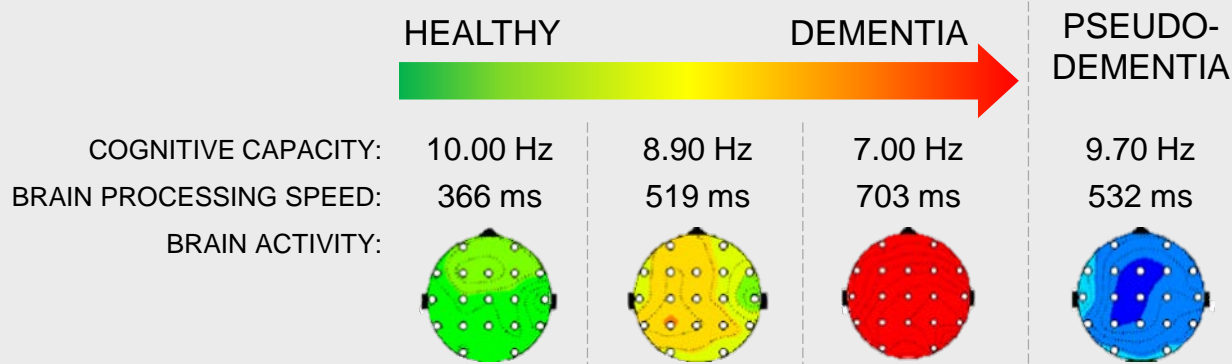

Frequently Asked Questions

What is eVox®?

The eVox System is a medical device that has received FDA 510(k) clearance for acquiring patients' electrical brain activity to aid in diagnosis. Physicians use eVox to assess brain health and aid in diagnosis of memory loss and other cognitive disorders.

What does eVox do for me?

eVox measures memory loss biomarkers. It provides an objective look at patients' brain activity using EEG imaging, which can show abnormal patterns that may help diagnose memory loss.

Do I have to be a specialist to use eVox?

eVox is perfect for primary care and specialty physicians who see patients suffering from memory loss. No prior neuroscience expertise is required to use eVox.

Is it reimbursable?

Yes, eVox procedures are reimbursed by Medicare and many commercial insurance carriers. The Medicare national average, without co-insurance, is \$739 in 2018¹.

Can a tech use the machine, or does a doctor have to be present?

The eVox assessment can be administered by any office staff, such as an MA, without the presence of a physician. However, billing requirements vary by state.

How is it used?

Patients with symptoms of memory loss complete the eVox assessment in your office. The test takes 10 minutes for patient prep; 25 minutes for data collection; 5 minutes between patients.

How much does it cost?

Refer to reverse page for pricing. eVox is qualified equipment under Section 179 for tax benefits in 2018, which could make bottom line equipment costs as low as \$10,207.

How much are the on-going costs to operate the device?

After the initial system purchase, there is an ongoing report fee of \$299 per report.

Is training, customer service, and a warranty included?

Your eVox System purchase includes on-boarding, training, customer service, and free software upgrades for life. Plus a 1 year warranty.
