### Traveling from the East:

Take Route 4 West to Route 208 North. Go five miles, and the church will be on your right.

### Traveling from the West:

Take Route 80 East to Route 287 North. Take Exit 59 to Route 208 South, and follow the directions listed below for *Traveling from the North.*

### Traveling from the South:

Take the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 160. At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Passaic Avenue. Take Passaic Avenue to Route 4 West. Take Route 4 West to Route 208 North. Go approximately five miles, and the church will be on your right.

### Traveling from the North:

Take Route 287 South to Route 208 South. Take the second Goffle Road exit [toward Midland Park and Ridgewood], and stay to the right. Make a right onto Route 208 North. The church will be on your right.
