and we're all traveling with them!**



Several adults from the congregation volunteered to join the bell choir, and Zion's "Liberty Bells" was born! Thanks to contributions from members of Zion's, we refurbished the bells, and since then we enjoyed their music many times, including Easter Sunday!.
