



## Bloomfield Recreation Summer Camps & Clinics

### Summer Camp (K-7)

Fewer than 50 spots remain open in Recreation Department summer camps. Parents are encouraged to sign up today! All sessions are supervised by department staff, certified teachers, para-professionals, student teachers and responsible young adults from the community. Nurses are on call at all times.

■ **Playgroup** (age 4-5 and kindergarten) at the Civic Center – Camp runs on weekdays from June 26 to Aug. 4 (except July 4). From 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., kids enjoy supervised sports, sprinkler parties, story times, imaginative play, arts and crafts, letters and numbers and themed lessons. Snacks are provided.

■ **Recreation Station** (grades 1-7) - Camp runs on weekdays from June 26 to Aug. 4 (except July 4). Sessions are at Watsessing Elementary School from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Early drop-off and late pick-up are available with advance sign-up and an added nominal fee. Three special trips will be offered for an added fee.

■ **Station II** (special needs, grades 1-7) – Camp runs on weekdays from June 26 to Aug. 4 (except July 4). Sessions are at Watsessing Elementary School from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Some students attend half-days instead of whole-days. The program includes sports and physical education, game room, special events, assemblies, optional field trips (extra fee required) and themed celebrations.

### Teen Travel Camp (grades 7-10)

From July 24 to Aug. 4, campers will take daily bus trips to Six Flags, Liberty Science Center, the Delaware Water for tubing, and more. Hours will be 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Buses will depart daily from the Bloomfield High School. All counselors will be first aid/AED-certified local teachers. Kids must wear camp-issued shirts on every trip. Maximum enrollment: 30 campers.

Registration Fees: One Week, \$300 • Two Weeks, \$575 (\$25 discount)

The fee includes all admission fees and transportation. Lunch and snacks are NOT included every day. Cancellations or postponements may occur due to extreme weather or unforeseen circumstances. In that event, alternatives such as bowling or movies will be offered, and arrangements will be made for delayed event admission or reimbursement.

### Summer Sports & Activity Clinics (ages 6-13)

More than 25 sport and non-sport clinics will be offered during the seven weeks of summer. For pricing, locations and registration, go to the website or sign up in person at the Civic Center. MasterCard and Visa accepted.

■ **Traditional and Non-Traditional Sports:** soccer, football, baseball, tennis and basketball, street hockey, fishing, golf, skateboarding, kickball, cheerleading and bowling.

■ **Non-Sport Activities:** magic, cooking, brain games, chess, art, guitar, hip hop dance and LEGO robotics.
