This class condenses the 101 and 102 Saison courses. Communication: Greetings, introductions, nationalities and numbers, expressing preferences, "tu" vs. "vous" forms of address; making a request; inviting, accepting and refusing; telling time; giving your opinion. Grammar: Basic irregular verbs; 'er' verbs ; introduction to pronouns adjectives and articles; possessives; interrogative forms; alphabet; numbers; "ne...pas"; near future tense; "il y a"; direct object pronouns; introduction to passé composé with "avoir"; idiomatic expressions. Phonetics: Intonation, rhythm, elision, vowel sounds, final sounds, some consonant sounds, liaison.*
