Edge to Edge Quilting

Love quilting? If you do, I am sure you may have difficulty free motion quilting the 3 layers after you have finished your piecing. Why pay someone else to do the quilting for you? We are going to learn to use a technique called Edge to Edge Quilting. It requires purchase of a book that you can order from **Norwalk Vac and Sewing** when you sign up for class.

Supplies needed:

- 45" pieced top,
- 47" square of cotton batting and

45" cotton fabric for the backing

- Spool of 50 wt. or 30 wt. cotton thread
- bobbin filled with the above cotton thread
- Quilting machine needle
- 1 yd. of woven interfacing (non-adhesive)
- black sewing thread with bobbin filled with same thread
- Edge to Edge Quilting Book

This embroidery class is open to owners of all type home embroidery machines.

A kit with fabrics, batting, needle, and interfacing available at class for \$45
