


Serger Class

Saturday July 7 12:30—3:30

Hawaiian Apron

This beautiful apron will be a hit at any Luau. You will need your serger and your sewing machine for this class. This is a special summer class. 3 hours long, 12:30—3:30

Bring the following supplies and have the pre-class work done. This way we can concentrate on getting the apron done



- I. Supplies:
 - a. 2 yard of cotton Hawaiian style fabric—prewash and pressed
 - b. 2 or 3 cones of serger thread
 - c. 1 cone of poly or wooley nylon thread
 - d. Serger
 - e. Sewing machine
 - f. Serger tools
 - g. Manual
 - h. Basic sewing supplies (needles, seam ripper scissors, rotary cutter, tweezers Etc.)
- II. Cut fabric after washing and pressing and before class
 - a. Cut 3 Straps—23" X 2 ½"
 - b. Cut 1 Lei ruffle 3" X WOF (Width of Fabric)
 - c. Cut 3 ruffle pieces for sides and bottom of apron (4" X WOF (Width of Fabric)
 - d. Optional Pocket 8" x 7"
