FORMER ASSOCIATION DIRECTOR JACK SALOIS HONORED ON STATE FIRE MEMORIAL WALL



Saturday, September 30, former Association Director Jack Salois's name was added to the the California Firefighters Memorial in Sacramento. The California Firefighters Memorial is a tribute to firefighters who have died in the line of duty since California became a state in 1850. The Memorial is located in Capitol Park.

As many of you know, Jack was a long-time Director of this Association and responsible for building our political infrastructure. He dedicated over four decades of his life to improving the quality of life for firefighters, their families, and police and fire retirees and survivors. Jack served as a union president for Santa Clara County firefighters, Local 1165, and in leadership roles for Local 230. Additionally, he was a City Hall adviser to former Councilmember John Diquisto.



Jack fought through two rounds of cancer that he developed due to his service as a firefighter for 36 years. Jack succumbed to his cancer in November of 2010.

In addition to Jack being added to the Memorial wall, San Jose Firefighter Felix Medrano was also honored on the wall. Felix served in the San Jose Fire Department for over 28 years before he succumbed to the effects of job-related cancer as well.
