Bluffton Worship Services

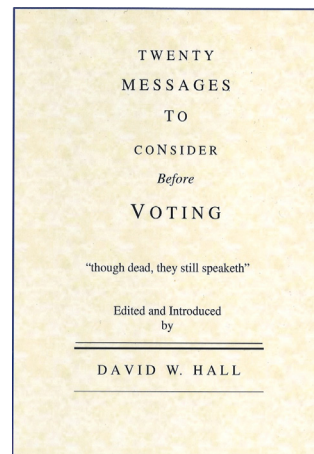
