



Mass Bay RRE and the Conway Scenic Railroad present:

'RED BALL SPECIAL'

(Boston) – North Conway, NH -- Crawford Notch – Hazens – Whitefield, NH & Return
Sunday, September 3, 2017 ONLY!!

As part of their Railfans' Weekend this year, on Sunday, September 3, the Conway Scenic Railroad will be operating a special train from North Conway to Whitefield and the famous ball signal at the junction of the former Boston & Maine and Maine Central Railroads. The Whitefield ball signal stands as the last signal of its type remaining in its original location. By special arrangement with the Conway Scenic, Mass Bay RRE has reserved 3 cars on this train for our members and guests.

This will be the first passenger train to operate over this section of the former Boston & Maine Berlin Branch since our two-day 'Day White Mountains' trip from Boston to Berlin, NH in May of 1982. Our excursion will depart from the Conway Scenic's landmark North Conway station promptly at 9:30 AM, heading north and west through Crawford Notch to Hazens. We'll continue west on the former Boston & Maine track for about 3 miles to the diamond at Whitefield. There we'll pose the train beside the ball signal for photos. Our return to North Conway is scheduled for around 5:30 PM.

The train will be the Conway Scenic's regular diesel-powered Notch Train consist. Mass Bay RRE has reserved two standard Conway Scenic coaches and the table car *Mount Webster*, which is now sold out! Discounted fares are available only to current Mass Bay RRE members. We will operate a connecting motorcoach from Boston & Woburn if there is sufficient demand to cover the cost. Call 978-470-2066 for details and pricing.

Train capacity is limited! Box lunches are available for advance purchase, or you may bring your own food. The Conway Scenic snack counter on board will offer snack and hot & cold beverage service throughout the day.
