  - Required background checks as an eligibility requirement for "adult" athletes on open teams will be included on the Final Release of the age grid.
- Routine time limit is a maximum of 2:30.
- The top 10 teams will advance from Semi-Finals to Finals
  - In the event that there are 40 or more teams total registered for a division, 15 teams will advance from either Prelims OR Semi-Finals. This will be determined by which ever round has more teams.

- An athlete must meet the age requirement at within the calendar year of 2019.
  - EXAMPLE: If a 13-year-old athlete is participating in a division where the minimum age is 14; that athlete is legal for the division if the athlete turns 14 on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
  - EXAMPLE: If a 19-year-old athlete is participating in a division where the maximum age is 18; that athlete would be legal for the division if the athlete was 18 years old at any time in 2019.
- Minimum number of athletes for all divisions is 16. A penalty may be assessed for taking the floor with fewer than 16 athletes.
- Routine time limit for IASF Divisions is a maximum of 2:30.
  - Exception: Routine time limit for NON - TUMBLING Divisions is a maximum of 2:00.
  - Exception: IASF Global Divisions - Time Limit: 3:30. Cheer = 30 seconds(minimum) 40 second (maximum), 20 seconds to move from cheer to and set for music portion, 2:30 maximum for music portion.
- The USASF member database will calculate the age on December 31, 2019. Required background checks as an eligibility requirement for "adult" athletes on open teams will be included on the Final Release of the age grid.
- The top 3 teams from each country will advance from Semi-Finals to Finals
- IASF Scoring System
- Global Divisions: Hundreds of thousands of young adults cheer at their schools each year which is automatic training for the National Team. These new divisions will give each country a training ground for athletes and their National Teams for ICU.
