## Estimated Cost: about \$2,200

Confucius Institute Headquarters and Shaanxi  
Normal University will cover expenses in China  
including food, accommodation, visits, tours and  
group activities. Students will be responsible for  
the costs related to international travel,  
international insurance, visa application fees, and  
any unfore-seen expenditures.

An annual Chinese language and culture camp  
experience sponsored by the Confucius Institute  
Headquarters in cooperation with Confucius  
Institute at the University of North Florida, and  
Shaanxi Normal University. This two-week  
program is structured to enhance understanding  
between American and Chinese students. Through  
a combination of classroom study and excursions,  
students have a unique opportunity to expand  
their language skills while experiencing China's  
rich culture and history on a personal level.

## Application Requirements

Participants must be registered through the  
Confucius Institute at UNF, aged 15-30, who have  
studied Chinese for no more than 3 years, and have  
not participated in a visit organized by Headquarters  
before. They must be an American Citizen (has a US  
passport), have an interest in Chinese language and  
culture, be healthy enough for travel, and be willing  
to participate in all camp activities.
