Tai-chi, calligraphy, brush painting, papercutting, Chinese language and culture classes, Chinese music & arts appreciation workshops, etc.

Visits to Chinese cultural landmarks, historical sites, and museums in Xi'an and Beijing.

Estimated Cost: about \$2,200

Confucius Institute Headquarters and Shaanxi Normal University will cover expenses in China including food, accommodation, visits, tours and group activities. Students will be responsible for the costs related to international travel, international insurance, visa application fees, and any unfore-seen expenditures.

Application Requirements

Participants must be registered through the Confucius Institute at UNF, aged 15-30, who have studied Chinese for no more than 3 years, and have not participated in a visit organized by Headquarters before. They must be an American Citizen (has a US passport), have an interest in Chinese language and culture, be healthy enough for travel, and be willing to participate in all camp activities.
