- Arrive at Visitor Center and meet private tour guide
- Explore the museum and view 13-minute video overview of the site.
 - Enjoy a private tour (60-90 minutes) of the ruins of the colonial estate of Noble Jones, a humble carpenter who arrived in Georgia in 1733 with James Oglethorpe and the first group of settlers from England. The tabby ruin is the oldest standing structure in Savannah.
- After the tour, there are 6 miles of nature trails you can opt to explore (everyone will be given a map). Trail length ranges from ½ mile to 4 miles.
