

The concert will feature the singing of One-Voice a local Christian musical group led by Sandra Baldwin. Since beginning in 2007 and recording a song on Sandra's album, "Just a Cup of Water," churches throughout New England have been thrilled by their sound. Sandra Baldwin has been directing choirs and ensembles since she was just 17 years old. She has taken groups on tour from New England to Canada and New York.
