## Other News and Reminders

**Who are the Bi-Fri's?** They are a caring group of mostly golden agers, who provide volunteer labor and skills for the church. The group had its origins from Roger Coakley, a very energetic and extremely helpful volunteer. Later, the group was formalized by the late Bob Brennan as a helpful, social group that made small repairs around the church. The concept was formally adopted by the Board of Trustees in November of 1995, when the group was officially acknowledged as the Bi-Fri Social Club. In the past 20-odd years, they have worked on many projects, large and small, generally doing small repairs or projects that frequently go unnoticed. Over the years, Bi-Friers have saved the church many thousands of dollars in repairs that would otherwise have been hired out. There is a tool room in the basement that is fairly well equipped, and many times volunteers will bring their own resources when needed.

This is a large church with a number of needs, and we could use more energy and help. Generally we meet the first and third Friday of each month (Bi-Fridays).
