DIRECTIONS

FROM ROCHESTER / SYRACUSE:

Camp is approximately 190 miles from Rochester / 100 miles from Syracuse.


> From I-81 N, take **exit 42 NY-177 E / S Harbor Rd** in Adams Center, NY

> From exit 42, drive along NY-177 for 30 miles and then it will turn into route 12

FROM LOWVILLE:

After 177 turns into Rt. 12, drive 2.9 miles into the town of Lowville, **take a right / south onto S. State Street** (Rt. 12) and drive $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. **Turn east / left on River Street** (see Stewart's on the SW corner, Stowe Street sign on your right). **Continue on River Street for 4 miles** (it becomes Number Four Road, also known as County Road 26). **At 4 miles veer left** (The Watson Inn will be “in front of you” as you turn left at what is more of a “Y” than a turn) to continue on Number Four Road. **Stay on Number Four Road for 13.5 miles. Turn right onto Stillwater Road** (shortly after you pass the Old Saw Mill Inn sign on your left, you will see signs for Stillwater Reservoir). **Continue 1.3 miles on Stillwater Road, and then turn left into Unirondack driveway**, which is marked by a tall sign on a tree - you may also see the large and brightly decorated Unirondack mailbox on the right. Follow a small dirt road for ~ one mile to the Camp Unirondack site. Drive slowly...it is a two way road!

When you see the first building on the right, that's the Dining Hall (Gilman) - pull up and check in!



GPS Coordinates: N 43 degrees, 51' (Minutes), 38.8" (Seconds) W 75 degrees, 9' (minutes), 29.2" (sec.)

NOTE: If an online mapping program suggests other directions, **DO NOT USE THEM!** This is the easiest and most reliable route; other routes can be much tougher **ESPECIALLY** in the dark...
