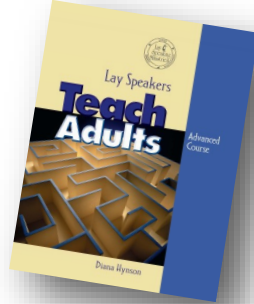
3) The Lay Servant Ministries' Basic Course—taught in Creole
