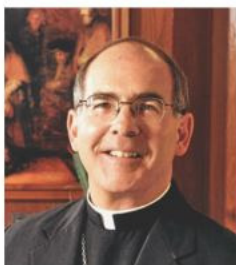
## **YOUTH MIGRANT CAMP MIDDLE SCHOOL MISSION TRIP – August 19 to 24**

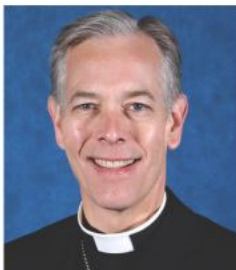
