What is the ONC Men's Service Center?

At the church fair on November 18th the ONC Men's Fellowship Group is running a 'Service Center' where fair visitors can purchase services provided by the male members and friends of ONC. This is the 7th year men have offered their services to raise money for the church. This Fact Sheet tells what services are provided, how those services are sold, and what men have to do to become a volunteer provider.

What services are to be provided?

The service center will offer any reasonable service that a volunteer is willing to provide. Generally, services fall in the following categories: **transportation, home maintenance & improvements, entertainment & recreation, learning, and others**. For example, men provided 30-40 rides to and from Logan in the past and we'd like to sell even more this year. A list of suggested services has been developed and is available with a signup form. Men can sign up to provide one or more of the suggested services or create their own service and add it to the list. Men, please sign up to do as many as you can.

How will these services be sold and delivered?

At the fair, visitors are provided with a Menu of Services identifying what services are offered, a short description of the service, the market value of that service, and the ONC price. The menu is comprised only of those services for which we have volunteers. Visitors who want a particular service will buy a voucher entitling them to that service. The voucher will contain the name and contact information of the person providing the service so that people can arrange for a mutually agreeable time and place to receive it.

How do men sign-up to provide a service?

To sign-up for providing your services, complete a printed **Sign-Up Form**. Sign-up Forms are available on Sundays in the Narthex after the 8:00 AM service or at coffee hour in the Parish Hall after the 10:00 AM service. Forms are also available as an attachment to the electronic weekly newsletter published by the ONC office. Give or send the form to **Tom Regan**.

What happens to the proceeds from the sales?

The proceeds from the purchase of services go directly to the Old North Church General Fund to underwrite the church's expenses and support its mission and outreach activities.
