Baseball

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BASEBALL: ALL AMERICAN PAST TIME
OBJECTIVE: TO SCORE RUNS BY CIRCLING THE BASES.
PLAYERS: 2
GRADE SPAN: 3-6
SKILLS: MATH
EQUIPMENT: DICE, PAPER, PENCIL, CRAYON AND 2 PENS.

HOW TO PLAY:
1. PRINT AND COLOR THE RULES AS BASEBALL.
2. ROLL THE DICE AND MOVE PAWNS AROUND THE DIAMOND. DICE GET OUTS OUTS.
3. AFTER THREE OUTS THE NEXT BATTER IS UP.
4. SCORE RUNS BY MOVING PAWNS AROUND THE BALL DIAMOND.
5. RECORD SCORE ON THE SCORE BOARD AS YOU PLAY EACH INNING.
6. PLAYER WITH MOST RUNS AT THE END OF 9 INNINGS WINS.

Directions

Baseball is a dice game. The rules are written on the right side of the game board. You play with the same rules as an outdoor baseball game.

You need 2 dice and 6 counters for each player. The game is played with 2 (teams) and goes 9 innings or as time allows.

Outs and hits are determined by looking at the number rolled on the side of the board under the “scoring column”. Your counters are used for moving runners around the bases.

Each player/team gets 3 outs in an inning and counts runs scored and records runs on the scoreboard. Scan the QR code for a video of “how to play the game”.

The object of the game is to score the most points.

HOW TO PLAY:

3. AFTER THREE OUTS THE NEXT BATTER IS UP.
4. SCORE RUNS BY MOVING PAWNS AROUND THE BALL DIAMOND.
5. RECORD SCORE ON THE SCORE BOARD AS YOU PLAY EACH INNING.
6. PLAYER WITH MOST RUNS AT THE END OF 9 INNINGS WINS.

- 3=TRIPLE
- 4=SINGLE
- 5=FLY OUT
- 6=STRIKE OUT
- 7=DOUBLE
- 8=DOUBLE PLAY – 2 OUTS
- 9=POP UP-OUT
- 10=WILD PITCH-RUNNERS ADVANCE
- 11=WALK
- 12=HOME RUN
