Take the Metrolink Train!

There is a Metrolink Station (**Anaheim Canyon Station**) on the Inland Empire Orange County Line. It is 3.9 miles from the event site.

For San Diego, the train leaves Oceanside at 7:39 a.m. arriving at 8:51 a.m. It should take about 8 minutes to get to the event site via taxi or Uber. The current rate is \$26 roundtrip.
